Youth Transitions to Adulthood (YTA)...

provides support and resources to teens who are learning to live independently. Committed and highly skilled McMan staff support youth with education, employment and life skills necessary to transition to healthy and positive adult living. The youth may share accommodations with a skilled adult mentor, live independently in the community or at the Launch Pad apartment complex which has an adult Residence Manager living on site.

We serve...

youth aged 15 to 22 years old who are unable to live with their natural families and require assistance to successfully live on their own. Teens involved in the YTA program are referred by Southeast Alberta Child and Family Services Authority.



At the age of 16, Maya was referred to McMan. She came from a violent and neglectful home - struggling with substance abuse, criminal activity and mental health issues. Maya was supported by the YTA staff with safe and stable housing, living skills coaching and ongoing emotional and social support. Five years later, Maya is completing her high school education and is both drug and crime free. Her plan is to pursue post-secondary education and be the best mom she can possibly be!
