Temporary Adult Shelter

Hours of Operation:
8:00 pm - 8:00 am
(until April 30, 2010)

The Winter's Inn is a temporary winter emergency response for homeless adults who are unable to access existing shelter services. We provide a safe warm place to sleep, nourishment and the opportunity to connect guests to appropriate community supports.

Occupancy:

- Up to 20 mats available.
- Guests must be 18 years or older.
- Males and females will be accommodated in separate areas.

For everyone's safety and comfort, we have three basic expectations of guests:

1. No illegal substances or potential weapons allowed on site.
2. Keep the peace.
3. One entry per guest per night.

Winter's Inn Facts:

- Winter's Inn is a **"damp" MAT project**. Individuals using alcohol or other substances are eligible.
- Guests will be **admitted one at a time** based on the most vulnerable condition.
- **One bag per guest** allowed in the building. All belongings will be safely locked for the night.
- Guests will be **required to empty all pockets, etc. followed by a pat down**. Any illegal or dangerous items will be confiscated.
- Guests will receive a **blanket, clean pair of socks, snacks and beverages** upon admission.
- **Guests will be asked to provide only basic information** to staff, (eg. name, age, any medical conditions, etc.)
- Doors will close at 3:00 a.m.
Checkout at 8:00 a.m.
- Guests of the Winter's Inn will be **connected to Housing First and other appropriate community resources** as needed.
- We cannot accommodate pets.
